Eskilstuna Track & Resort will further strengthen the municipality's profile in terms of sustainable development. Eskilstuna has already established the world's first climate-smart shopping centre and is home to the headquarters of Volvo CE – a company that works with innovative and sustainable products and services.

Updated with the latest products and services from Volvo CE, the Eskilstuna Track & Resort is a great place for partners to engage with their stakeholders. The track has already been used as a test bed for the development of the World RX rallycross tracks' turns (where Volvo CE together with Swecon, a distributor of Volvo products and services, are official partners for the track construction) and will continue to be used as such even after the environmental transformation.
